ACROSS THE STATE



Nonprofits employ **1 million Texans**, and support the employment of an additional **224,000 Texans** through indirect and induced economic effects



Nonprofit throughout Texas spent more than **\$96 billion** in 2019, and contributed an additional **\$41 billion** to the state's economy through indirect and induced effects.



That's an additional **\$0.43** for every dollar spent by nonprofits!




