Nonprofits employ 1 million Texans, and support the employment of an additional 224,000 Texans through indirect and induced economic effects



Nonprofit throughout Texas spent more than **\$96 billion** in 2019, and contributed an additional **\$41 billion** to the state's economy through indirect and induced effects.



That's an additional \$0.43 for every dollar spent by nonprofits!




