The size of the sector continues to grow.

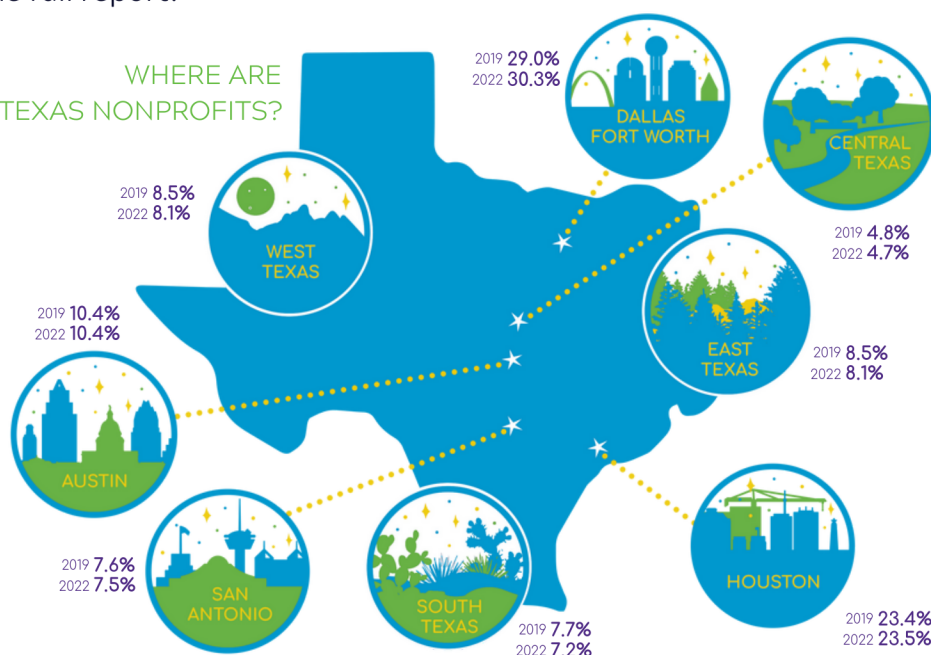
There are more than **130,000 nonprofits** across the state of Texas.

The sector has **grown by 22%** between **2015** and **2022**.

WHERE ARE TEXAS NONPROFITS?



Revenue for nonprofits is not matching the growth of the sector overall.

Despite its 22% growth, the sector's **total revenue grew by only 13%** across the state. Revenue growth varies greatly by region and by type of nonprofit.

The typical nonprofit is **only 15 years old** and nearly **half of Texas nonprofits (47%)** were **founded after 2010**.

Nearly 75% of Texas nonprofits report having a **budget under \$50,000**, which is **more than 60,000 organizations**.
